'Veni Creator Spiritus' is attributed to Rabanus Maurus, a 9th century priest, and is the oldest hymn in common use today. When the original Latin text is used, it is usually sung in Gregorian chant, similar to

the melody heard in this morning's prelude. It is an invocation of the Holy Spirit sung during the feast of Pentecost, but is also sung on special occasions such as the entrance of Cardinals to the Sistine Chapel when electing a new pope. The chant is also used during Anglican Communion and first appeared, in English, in the Book of Common Prayer, 1662. There are numerous translations in several languages. Two can be found in Voices United, 200 and 201.
