Prayer Cycle for the United Churches in Hamilton Conference: Westminster United Church, St. Catharines, Niagara Presbytery

The words for the hymn 'Sing Praise to God, Who Has Shaped' (VU 221) were written by the German poet Joachim Neander in 1680. He was the first important hymn writer of the German Reformed Church. 19 of his hymns could be found in the 1680 edition of the Lutheran hymnal and many are still widely in use today. The text for this hymn was set to the tune 'Lobe Den Herren', which first appeared in an earlier publication with different words. The composer of the tune is unknown. Neander used this music for another of his poems, 'Praise to the Lord, the Almighty' (VU 220), which also appeared in the 1680 hymnal.
