Prayer Cycle for the United Churches in Hamilton Conference: Jarvis and Garnet United, Erie Presbytery



César Franck (1822-1890) was a Belgian born composer, pianist, organist and music teacher. His father saw him as a young piano prodigy and pushed César and younger brother Joseph to study at the Paris Conservatoire. César

was forced to give concerts and teach privately in order to pay his tuition. At first these concerts were well received but his father's increasingly commercial promotion of his sons turned music critics against them, resulting in an abrupt decision to return the family to Belgium. A complete break from his family came in 1848 with his marriage to an actress seen as being beneath the family. Franck moved back to Paris and embarked on a very successful career as a composer, church organist and teacher at the Paris Conservatoire.
