Prayer Cycle for the United Churches in Hamilton Conference:
Japanese United Church, Hamilton



Harriet Tubman (1822-1913) was an escaped African-American slave who made some 13 missions to rescue approximately 70 enslaved family and friends using the Underground Railroad. Because many slaves knew the secret meanings of their music, these songs could be used to signal many things. For example, Tubman used 'Wade In the Water' to tell escaping slaves to get off the trail and into the water to make sure the dogs slave catchers used couldn't sniff out their trail. Tubman also used slave songs to relay other messages. Sometimes she had to leave a group she was leading in order to get food or other necessities. She would tell them to hide and wait for her signal. If she came back and sang one song two times, they would know it was safe to come out of hiding. If there was danger she would sing a particular song to tell them to stay put until she sang the "all clear" song..

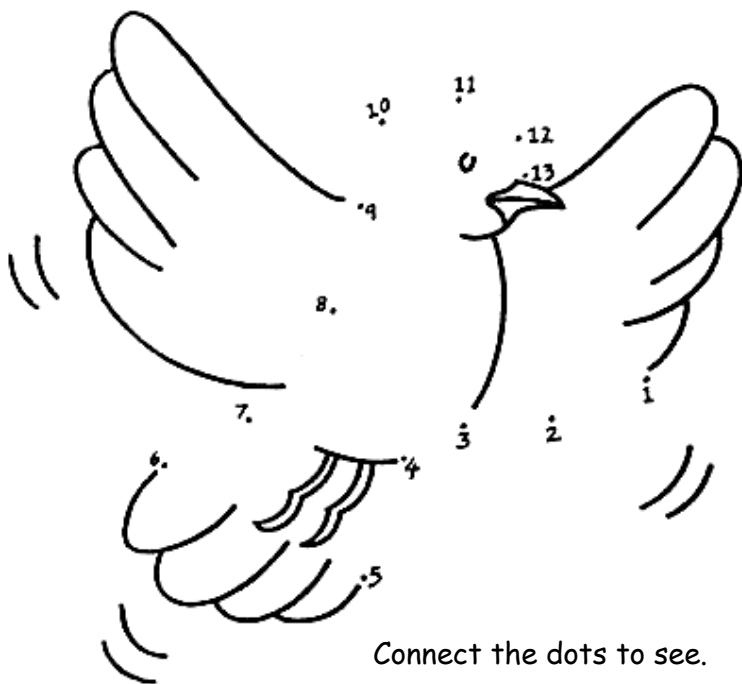
