The Well-Tempered Clavier (Vol. I) is a collection of 24 preludes and fugues in all major and minor keys composed for solo keyboard by J. S. Bach in 1722. In Bach's time Clavier (keyboard) was a generic

name indicating a variety of keyboard instruments, typically the harpsichord or clavichord (the piano hadn't been invented yet). They were intended as teaching tools. Bach's title suggests that he wrote these for a 12-note 'well-tempered' tuning system in which all keys (scales) sounded in tune. During his time the more common tuning system was 'meantone temperament' where keys with many accidentals (black notes) would sound out of tune. Bach wrote a 2nd collection (Vol. 2), twenty years later.
