MUSIC Notes 'The Armed Man' (subtitled 'A Mass for Peace') is by Welsh composer Karl Jenkins. The piece was commissioned by the Royal Armouries Museum for the Millennium celebration and was dedicated to

victims of the Kosovo crisis. The mass is essentially an anti-war piece which charts the growing menace of a descent into war, interspersed with moments of reflection. It shows the horrors that war brings and ends with the hope for peace in the new millennium.

The text for the refrain of 'World Peace Prayer' was written by Satish Kumar, a peace activist and teacher living in Great Britain. This refrain has been translated into several languages. The verses and music for this hymn were written by Marty Haugen, a prolific composer of liturgical music in the United States.
