"I Will Arise and Go to Jesus" is the alternate title and refrain for the hymn "Come Ye Sinners, Poor and Needy". It first appeared in print in William "Singin' Billy" Walker's 'Southern Harmony' in 1835, the most popular tune book of the 19th century. Walker was a singing school instructor in South Carolina and Southern Harmony was compiled to teach his students how to read music. It contained 335 sacred songs in shape



notation (circles, triangles, squares and diamonds representing the pitches). Many Southern Harmony

songs still appear in hymnals today including 'Amazing Grace' and 'Wondrous Love'.


IPods Wanted!
