MUSIC Motes Giovanni Battista Pescetti (c. 1704 -1766) was an organist and composer who was born in Venice. His compositional output consists mainly of operas and in 1736 he moved to London to become

director of the Opera of the Nobility (an opera company set up by a group of nobles who opposed George II of England, in order to compete with the Royal Academy of Music, a company backed by the King). Pescetti had to return to Venice in 1745 because of hostility in London again Catholic Italians. He became organist at St. Mark's Basilica and was an active teacher of composition.
