Für Elise (in English, For Elise) was composed by Ludwig von Beethoven around 1810, but the identity of "Elise" is a mystery. The name was attached because a Beethoven researcher claimed

to have seen this dedication on the original manuscript which has since gone missing. The piece wasn't printed until over 40 years after Beethoven's death and no records, letters or accounts from people make any mention of an 'Elise' in the composer's life. One theory is that the researcher misread the composer's bad hand writing for what might have read "Für Therese". Beethoven was in love with a woman, Therese Malfatti, at around the time of composition. In 2009, another researcher made the claim that "Elise" may have been the nickname of an opera singer, Elisabeth Rockel, whom Beethoven met a few years prior to writing the piece.
