Skylight Festival Get on the bus and come with us! On Sunday, July 31, three local United Churches – Trinity, St. James'-Rosemount and First - are boarding a bus (or 2...or 3) to attend the worship service at the Skylight Festival in Paris, ON. The bus will depart from & return to St. James'-Rosemount (171 Sherwood Ave). Tickets for the bus must be purchased in advance.

Bus Boarding time on July 31: 8:30 to 8:40 am

Bus departs from Kitchener: 8:45 sharp

Bus departs from Paris: immediately after the worship service (approx. 12 noon, possibly earlier)

Cost: \$10 per person – **cash only**. There is no gate charge at the festival for those who are attending only the worship service. The cost of the ticket, assuming a sold-out bus, covers the cost of driver and bus, a tip for the driver, and a donation to Skylight Festival. **Tickets will be on sale:** before & after worship services on July 3, 10, 17, 24 **Tickets will be sold on a first-come-first-served basis**. In order to ensure full bus(es), tickets cannot be reserved/held beyond the Sunday immediately following the date of the request. In other words, any tickets you request be put on hold for you between Mon. July 4 and Sat. July 9 <u>must</u> be paid for and picked up on Sun. July 10; tickets requested from Mon. July 11 to Sat. July 16 must be paid for and picked up on Sun., July 17, etc. Unclaimed tickets will not be held beyond the Sunday specified.

<u>Your regular church offering envelope for July 31:</u> please put it on the plate on August 7. Those who are unable to join us at the Skylight worship service are warmly invited to an **alternate worship service on July 31 at First United** beginning at 10:30 am in their chapel.
