

Music Notes Barrie Cabena was born and educated in Melbourne, Australia. He continued his musical studies at the Royal College of Music in London, England and then in 1957 made Canada his home. He has a rich musical

background with nearly 500 compositions to his credit. In addition, he has written a sizeable quantity of verse, some of which is included in his compositions. His organ and choral works have been broadcast by the CBC for more than 47 years. His requiem for the Victims of Terrorism, composed in response to the September 11, 2001 terrorist attack, was recorded for broadcast on CBC radio. Dr. Cabena has been a church organist in London, Kitchener-Waterloo and Guelph where his choirs gained a reputation for quality and skill. After 27 years on the Faculty of Music at Wilfrid Laurier University, Barrie retired in 1996 but continues to maintain a keen interest in music education as Professor Emeritus.

SJR Boiler Replacement! Over the next couple of weeks, thanks to the diligence of the Property Committee and chair Dave Bird, SJR will be replacing the boiler of the church. After months of research, we have chosen Viessmann Vitodens boilers installed by Conestogo Mechanical, with the complete installation cost to just over \$51000. This will change our rating from 60-70% efficient to 90-95% efficiency. Because of the generosity of many people over the years, our Capital Fund is able to pay for this purchase outright. This reduces the Capital Fund to around \$64000. Thank you to all those who continue to support the ongoing ministry of our church, and we look forward to toasty warm Sundays in the winter!!
