

This week's offertory was composed by Romain-Octave Pelletier I (1843-1927), a Montreal-born Ausic organist, pianist, composer and music educator. Notes Largely self-taught, he received early music lessons from his elder brother and took his first organist position at the age of 15. "We Are One" (VU 402), was written by Doreen Lankshear-Smith of Thunder Bay in 1988. The tune was written by Jeeva Sam, a United Church minister from St. Catherine's, in 1987, and was arranged by David Kai, a diaconal minister who has served charges in Manitoba and Ontario. Both Sam and Kai have a number of compositions in Voices United and Kai also served on the committee that produced our hymn book. Finally, our anthem was composed by Christopher Tye (1506(?) - 1573), an English Renaissance composer and organist who was the master of the choir of Ely Cathedral and the music teacher to Edward VI of England. He is best known for the hymn "Winchester Old" which forms the basis of "While Shepherds Watched Their Flocks".
